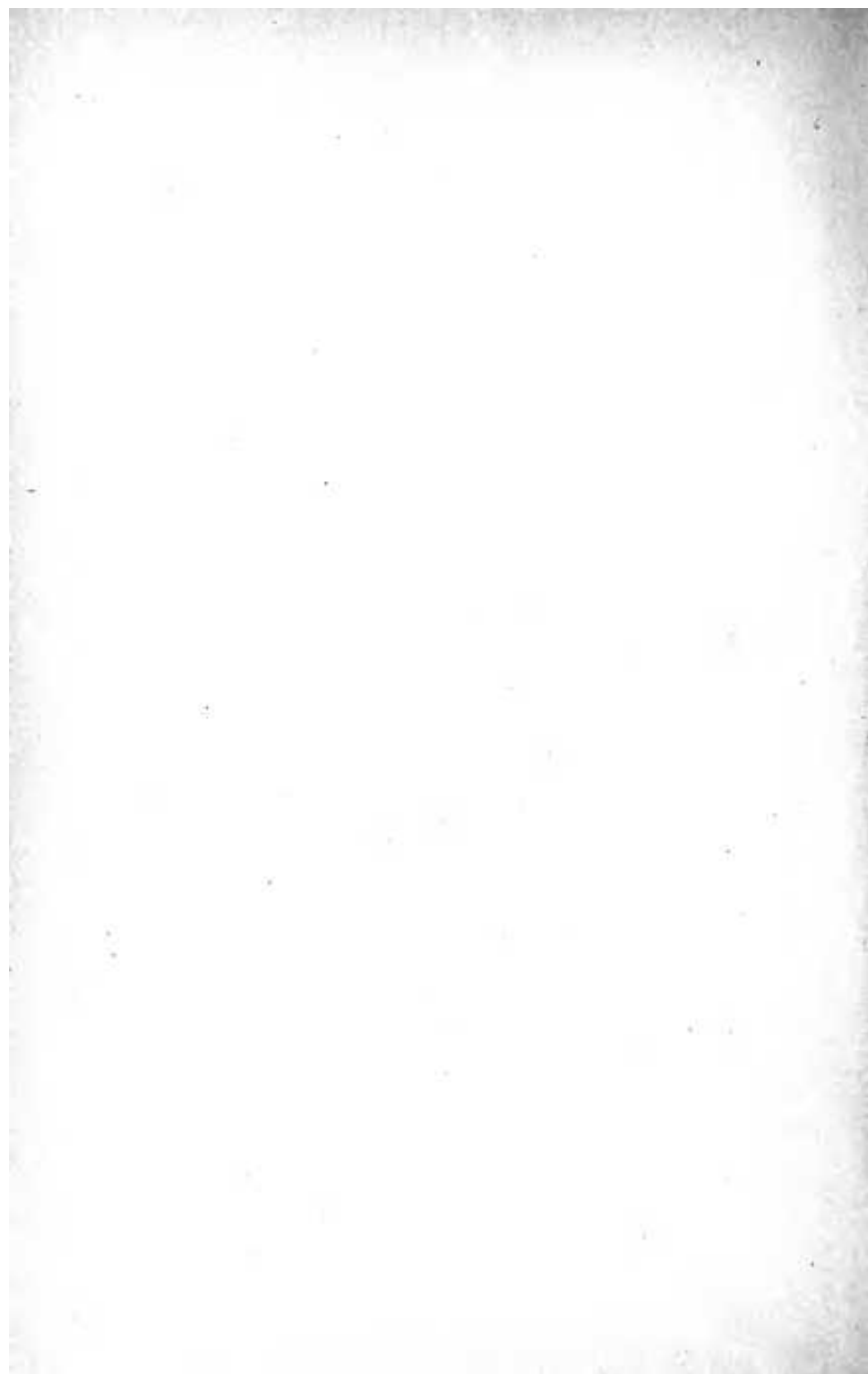

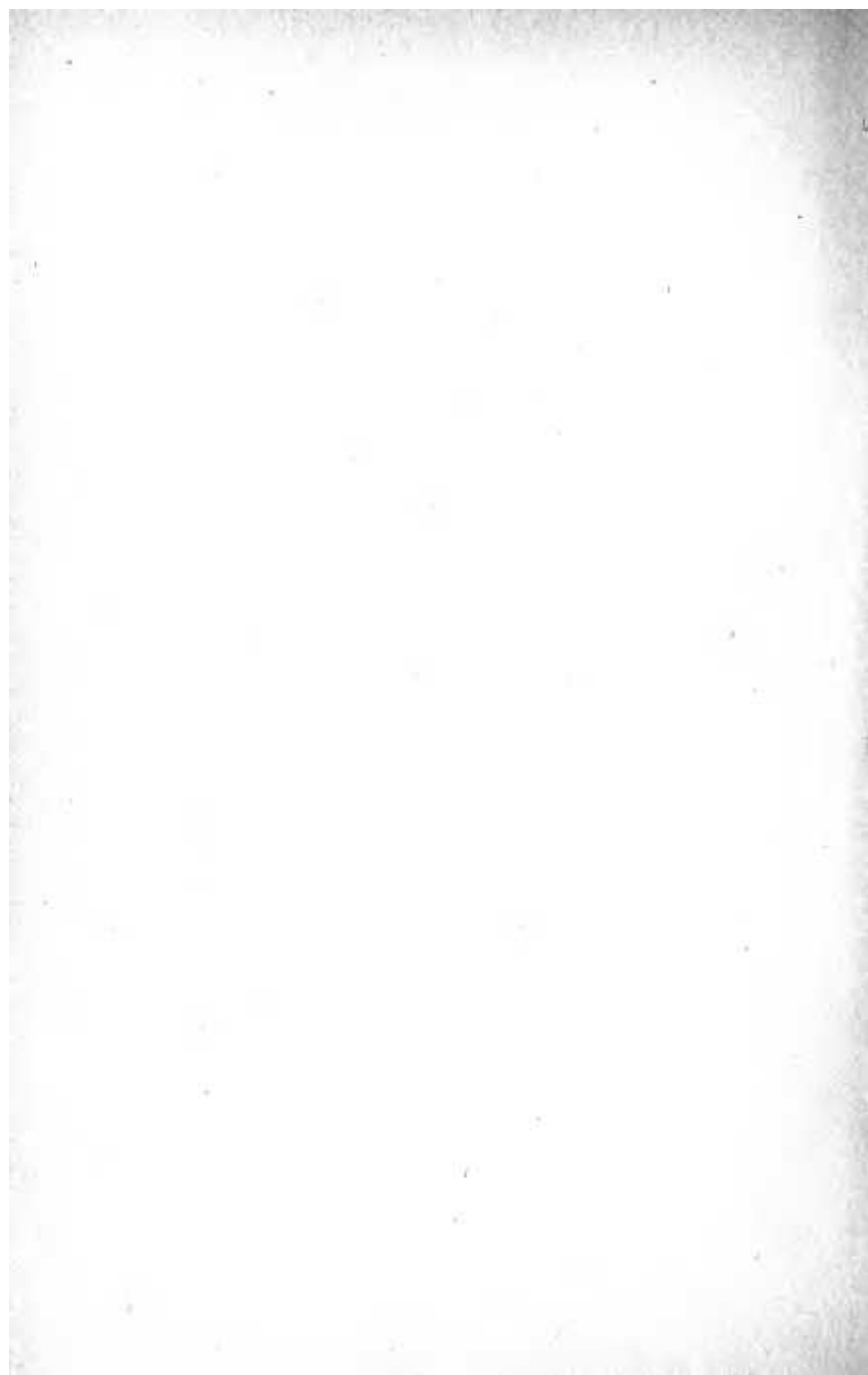
ADVERTISEMENT
