PREFACE

TO DRAMATIC INDEX, 1920.

There are now twelve annual volumes of THE DRAMATIC INDEX, and such an index to Contemporary Drama, and modern actors, actresses, playwrights has never before been available.

The series, of which this 1920 volume is now available, furnishes a key to practically every phase of the Drama—a portrait index also to every player of any prominence on stage or screen during the last fifteen years.

Drama League Monthly ceased publication and is replaced by *The Drama*, monthly, a continuation of *Drama* (quarterly) of which nine volumes were issued. *New York Dramatic News* has been dropped as not lending itself to the sort of indexing our INDEX covers.

The New York Clipper and *Photoplay Magazine* have been added this year by request of librarians. *New World*, London, a new monthly containing valuable material on the stage has been added.

It should be understood that many periodicals are covered for dramatic material which are not mentioned in the list at the beginning of this book.

Although many dramatic books and plays are included in the body of THE DRAMATIC INDEX, with periodical articles, these, and many others are also listed separately in THE APPENDIX at the end of the volume.
