





The last edition of the pamphlet on Stocking has been out of print for some months, while this issue has been delayed through the pressure of other work, and the necessity of practically rewriting the pamphlet to bring it up to date.

The first edition had to beg the whole question of modern fish-culture, the fourth edition finds artificial Stocking very generally adopted, and trout farms established in many places in England and Scotland as purely commercial ventures, thriving both fishculturally and financially.

The public, at least the angling portion thereof, is already very much up to date on the subject, the size and colour of eggs, the length and shape of yearlings or two-year-olds, are questions on which it holds a very decided opinion, nor is it any longer necessary to point out, as in the
