name;* for I am without beginning of days or end of years;' and is not this endless?

4. And, behold, thou art my son; wherefore look,^m and I will show thee the workmanship of mine hands;ⁿ but not all, for my works are without end,^o and also my words, for they never cease.^P

5. Wherefore, no man can behold all my works, except he behold all my glory; and no man can behold all my glory, and afterwards remain in the flesh on the carth.⁴

6. And I have a work for thee, Moses, my son; and thou art in the similitude of mine Only Begotten;^r and mine Only Begotten^{*} is and shall be the Savior,^{*} for he is full of grace and truth;^{*} but there is no God beside me, and all things are present with me, for I know them all.^{*}

7. And now, behold, this one thing I show unto thee, Moses, my son; for thou art in the world, and now I show it unto thee.

8. And it came to pass that Moses looked, and beheld the world upon which he was created;⁴⁰ and Moses beheld the world and the ends thereof, and all the children of men which are, and which were

9. And the presence of God^{ν} withdrew from Moses, that his glory was not upon Moses;^s and Moses was left unto himself. And as he was left unto himself, he fell unto the earth.^a

10. And it came to pass that it was for the space of many hours before Moses did again receive his natural strength like unto man; and he said unto himself: Now, for this cause I know that man is nothing,^b which thing I never had supposed.

11. But now mine own eyes have beheld God;⁶ but not my natural,⁶ but my spiritual eyes, for my natural eyes could not have beheld;⁶ for I should have withered and died in his presence;⁷ but his glory was upon me;⁶ and I beheld his face,⁸ for I was transfigured before him.⁴

12. And it came to pass that when Moses had said these words, behold, Satan' came tempting^k him, saying: Moses, son of man,' worship me.^m

13. And it came to pass that Moses looked upon Satan^{*} and said: Who art thou? For behold, I am a son of God, in the similitude of his Only Begotten;^o and where is thy glory, that I should worship thee?
