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CONSTITUTION.

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- ARTICLE 1. This Society shall be called the Memorandum Society of Mount Holyoke Female Seminary.
- ARTICLE 2. The object of this Society shall be to obtain and perpetuate facts relative to the members of the Institution, and their future history; and also to increase the facilities for the improvement of its members while connected with the Seminary.
- ARTICLE 3. The payment of \$2.00 will constitute an individual a member for life.
- ARTICLE 4. It shall be the duty of every member of the Society, to write a letter (post-paid) in Jan. of every fifth year, (viz. 1847, 1852, &c...) to the Secretary of the Society, communicating facts relative to herself and others, who have been members of the Seminary.
- ARTICLE 5. The Society shall print a catalogue of all its members with their latest reported residence, every fifth year; a copy of the same shall be transmitted to each member, also a copy of the annual catalogue each year, and any important documents, which may be published by the Society.
- ARTICLE 6. A library shall be owned by the Society for the use of its members, while connected with the Seminary, to which may be devoted the avails of life membership, not otherwise appropriated.
- ARTICLE 7. The officers shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Assistant-Secretary, and Treasurer.
- ARTICLE 8. The officers shall constitute a Board of Managers to transact the business of the Society.
- ARTICLE 9. The Annual Meeting shall be the first Wednesday in Nov. when officers shall be chosen. All other meetings shall be appointed by the Board of Managers.
