



CHRONOLOGICAL TABLE.

The dates mark the time when the Jewish highpriests and governors entered upon their offices, rather than the beginning of the reigns of the contemporary kings, who ruled over Judea. The five great foreign powers which held rule over Judea are noted in their successive order. For the sake of distinguishing in the Jewish offices, let g. stand for governor, h. for highpriest, and g. h. for the union of the two in one person.
