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time so that it could be used without producing syphilitic symptoms is made clear. It has been demonstrated that syphilis can be inoculated upon cows. The author urges that cow-pox should be made a notifiable disease in order that, whenever a case occurs, it may be traced to its true source. The reason why this has not hitherto been done is that it would mean the immediate cessation of vaccination.

CHAPTER III.—Cow-Pox, OR Cow-Syphilis
LYMPH: THE ONLY MATTER WHICH CAN BE
LEGALLY USED FOR PREPARING VACCINE
LYMPH

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The fact is brought out here that all the statements made by pro-vaccinists as to the value of vaccine lymph are based upon the exclusive use of cow-pox lymph. Cases are cited where syphilitic symptoms and death have occurred from the use of vaccine lymph when the persons vaccinated were proved to have been free from that disease. The important group of cases cited by the late Sir J. Hutchinson are fully set forth, in which this great authority on syphilis said: "The final supposition is that it is possible for vaccination, independently of any syphilis, whether implanted or inherited, to evoke symptoms which have hitherto been regarded as peculiar to the latter malady and which are apparently greatly benefited by specific treatment." It is shown that protozoan organisms similar to those found in syphilis are also known to be present in vaccine lymph, while spirochœtæ, or male syphilitic organisms, have been discovered in vaccine pustules. most important link, however, to connect the two diseases is that made by an American doctor. He states definitely that recently vaccinated persons,

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who have never contracted syphilis nor inherited it, when subjected to the Wassermann test show a positive reaction, which means that they have to all intents and purposes contracted syphilis from the vaccination. This most damning testimony brands 'calf lymph' as a form of syphilis and should convince even the most sceptical that the practice should be stopped.

### CHAPTER IV.—INOCULATION FOR SMALL-POX

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In this chapter it is shown that it is an illegal procedure to use small-pox virus for the purpose of producing vaccine lymph. Jenner and his friends were most strongly opposed to the practice, and it was chiefly through their efforts that its use was forbidden by law. The Medical Experts of the Local Government Board wish to revert to modified inoculation by preparing vaccine lymph from small-pox. They have prepared a form of variolous lymph taken from small-pox corpses, and passed through monkeys, which they now say has not been used except for experimental purposes; yet the lymph at present in use is known to be obtained from a similar form of lymph, but it is obtained from Germany. In this way questions asked in Parliament can be evaded.

### CHAPTER V.—THE INCREASED INFANT MORTALITY

DUE TO VACCINATION

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The deadly effects of vaccination upon the health and lives of the infant population are referred to here. It is also shown that the infant death-rate has steadily decreased in proportion as vaccination, under the Conscience Clause, has fallen into disrepute.

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### CHAPTER VII.—SMALL-POX IS NATURE'S REMEDY FOR SYPHILIS

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In this final chapter it is shown that an attack of small-pox is the means adopted by Nature for fully clearing away from man's body, by a surface elimination, syphilitic organisms and other impurities, thus making him internally clean. The New Bacteriology is discussed, which shows that bacteria are not the true cause of disease, but rather that they are an essential part of the bodily mechanism of defence against the minute infecting agents or sporozoites of syphilis and other protozoan toxins. The theory evolved is that such germs as the colon bacillus found in the human bowels, the tubercle bacillus, the diphtheria bacillus, the typhoid fever germ, and all other germs capable of cultivation outside the body, are intermediary organisms. They are not introduced

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into the system from without, but are actually detached by the living cells of the tissues themselves. They are a form of first-aid to preserve the tissue cells from that inevitable destruction which would await them if the sporozoites or toxins could attack and enter into them as para-The second stage in this mechanism of defence is for the phagocytes or white blood corpuscles to eat up the virus-laden bacteria and to then promptly take them to the lymphatic glands, where a special glandular secretion can destroy them. When the amount of virus or the number of bacilli and phagocytes is too great for the glands to deal with, then the next step in bodily defence is for the phagocytes to be taken to the surface, where they can be promptly extruded. Incidentally pneumonia, tuberculosis and other septic diseases are shown to be due to a failure of the phagocytes to reach either the glands or the skin. Cancer also is shown to be due to a failure on the part of the bodily cells to provide bacteria, the result being that the cells are invaded and the male and female parasites are produced, resulting in tumour formation. When the bodily mechanism works satisfactorily an attack of small-pox supervenes or a crop of boils or a large abscess occurs. The supreme importance of cleanliness is urged as the best means of preventing small-pox. Digestive and hygienic cleanliness, as well as mental, moral and sexual cleanliness, are urged as the one and only way by which the human race can attain to that pitch of good health which ought to be the birthright of all, and would make such diseases as syphilis or epidemic small-pox well-nigh impossible.
