

In consequence of the length to which the present work has extended, it has been found necessary to divide it into two portions, the present being Part I.

1582.

Receyved sithence the seventh of Sept'ber 1582 as foloweth:—

besse [beasts] taken into the lower grounds at Smythiles

anno domini 1582.

In primis John Robert ij oxen, xiiij. Jas Greves, a stirke and a twinter [twain-winter, two winters old] viij ijd xpoffer hill, a twinter kowlt x vjd m leaver of the chamber one beast gate and

a halffe x* vid (the halffe baste is payed for) Homfrey Atherton eleven besse the price for every one vij* (M* Leaver of the chamber did take out the sd beastes and had theme in but for iiij weekes.)

Horses goinge in the lower ground at Smythills.

Homfrey Atherton a geldinge x Richard lever of little lever x

Besse taken into egburden.

Hughe Woode a twinter and a stirke iiij viijd xpoffer hill iiij oxen xvj* the said xpoffer iiij oxen for a three weekes ij* Rauffe Bleasdale one twinter ijs viijd Robert Heaton one beast iiijs George Longworthe ij beastes viij Hughe Woode ij stirkes iiij Hamer Crompton ij stirke vj. Robert grenenoughe ij oxen for a three weekes xijd Hughe woode a stirke from the vijth of June untill michelmas xxijd Hughe woode a stirke from Whitsonday untill St. Mergarette daye viijd Dakin, one stirke from the sixt of June unto michelmes ij* Thomas marche for iij beastes from the viijth of September xviijd Ellis houlden xj lames from the xxth of June [no sum]. Hughe woode x lames from the xxvijth daye of June unto the second of September ijs iijd Seathe man a stirke from the third of Julic unto the sixte of Auguste vijd woode ij oxen from the xxth of Julie untell the third of aguste xijd Edmund Turner viij lames from the xxth of Julie untell the vijth of auguste painge for the same iiijd.

Hughe woode a horse viij* Rauffe Bleasdale a yeare ould cowlte iiij* Roger Walmisley a horse viij* James Molineux ij twinter coultes xij* m^r Leaver of the chamber a yearinge cowlte for a fortenight viijd Gilbert Weather one horse from the xxvjth daye of aprill and taken out the first of June xx^d the said Gilbert ij horses from the iiijth daye of Menye and taken out the xvijth of June iiij* Homfray Atherton a horse half a score iiij* Robt Stones a horse from the xvijth of maye untill michelmas [no sum].

Payed out of this mony weh I recev'd for paye at tyngreffe weh was iiijli xiijs unto me mullynex vs for rente. Item unto me stopforthe for winde corne seewer xiijs iiijd. Item payed for movinge [mowing] and gettynge have at tyngreffe xxv vijd.

Sould unto Richard Leaver so muche woole as comethe unto xiijii vijs due to be paid at michelmas and I have his bound for the same.

Sould to Homfray Atherton so muche woolle as comethe to liiijs and I have a bill for the same.

Barlie sould at tingreave by will'm Duckworthe.

In primis xxij'is meates [metts] iij'ii. sould by the said Will'm viij meates of barlie and halffe a pecke xxij' vjd due to be paid at

michelmas next. sould bee Homfrey Atherton xxij^{tis} meates of barlie unto Hughe Tomson the pryce iij^{II} to bee paid at michelmas next. Barlie sould by the said Homfrey at Howle to bee paid at michelmas next iij meates, the pryce vij² vj⁴.

haye ground sete att lastoke, anno domini 1582.

In primis unto John morres an aker caled the horne meddowe x* the said John the littell meddow v* John warintoun one aker and a rowd land caled Drylowse xiij* iiij⁴ John holme halffe an aker iiij* vj⁴ John horabine an aker viij* roberte houlden halffe a rowde land and towe falle xviij⁴ m⁴ that my mestier rased my [wages] gene John horebien towe shillinges agene in consideracione of his povertie.

1582.

Sould unto Markeland of wyggane towe horssies for fiffe markes due to be payed at candelmes nexte. Sete at howle one closes of eddies [eddish] unto a thrie wyke after crestemas for v^h vjⁱ viij^d due to be payed at crestemes nexte:

Cattell taken to gresse in Egbordeyn the iijth day of May Anno Domini 1583, as followeth:

Imp'mis Robert Broke two oxen and a cowe xij* Willyam Holme a whye twinter ij* viijd a coult iiij* a heffer iiij* Fyve beastyates and a halffe xxij* Three beast-yates xij*; a horse viij*; a mear of twoe yeares of age vj*; a horse for a moneth xxd; a coulte of the age of twoe yeares vi*; a stirke ij*; twoe oxen viiij*; a weake gresse for a horse vjd; foure stirkes the halffe score iiij*.

Cattel taken into the Mosse at Lostocke the iij day of maye as followethe, 1588.

Haye ground setted at hoole in the xxvth yeare of the Reann of the queenes ma^{te} y^t nowe is after xj^t the acre to these psons hereafter followinge. 1583.
