



### PREFACE.

In the following pages an attempt has been made to bring together, in a short and concise form, the more modern views regarding gleet and its treatment, as given by recent authorities on the subject, more especially Van Buren and Keyes, Burnstead, Berkeley Hill, Ch. Phillips, and Otis. No originality is claimed. as the remarks are merely a compilation prepared from the works of the above-mentioned authors for use in clinical teaching; but as considerable experience in the treatment of cases of the kind has shown the writer that the mode of examination and the methods of treatment inculcated are both satisfactory and efficient, it occurred to him that this short resumé might prove of use to those among his medical brethren who are not familiar with the more recent utterances of authorities on Venereal Disease.

On this account, he has reprinted the lecture from the *Edinburgh Medical Journal*, with some additional annotations in order to make the paper more complete; and a lithographic plate has been introduced for the purpose of rendering the description of the instruments given in the text more intelligible to those who may wish to follow out the treatment suggested, but who may not be acquainted with all the appliances referred to.
