

#### LESSON I.

THE WORK OF CHRIST CONTINUED IN THE ACTS OF HIS APOSTLES, WHO DO EVERYTHING UNDER HIS GUI-DANCE AND BY HIS POWER-CHARACTERISTICS OF THE BOOK OF THE ACTS-CHRIST'S LAST CHARGE TO HIS APOSTLES-HIS ASCENSION-THE UPPER ROOM-THE DAYS OF WAITING BETWEEN ASCENSION AND FENTECOST. (Ch. i.)

THE four Gospels contain, as we have seen, a selection of the words and actions of the Lord Jesus Christ; and these are followed in the New Testament by a fifth book, in which St. Luke,'--who in his evangelistic history kad written "concerning all things that Jesus *began* to do and to teach, until the day He was taken up,"-resumes his narrative from where it had been broken off, and further relates what our Lord *continued* to do after He had completed our redemption by His death and was ascended into Heaven.

In the Gospels we see the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of Man taking the form of a servant, and humbling Himself even to the death of the Cross; but in
