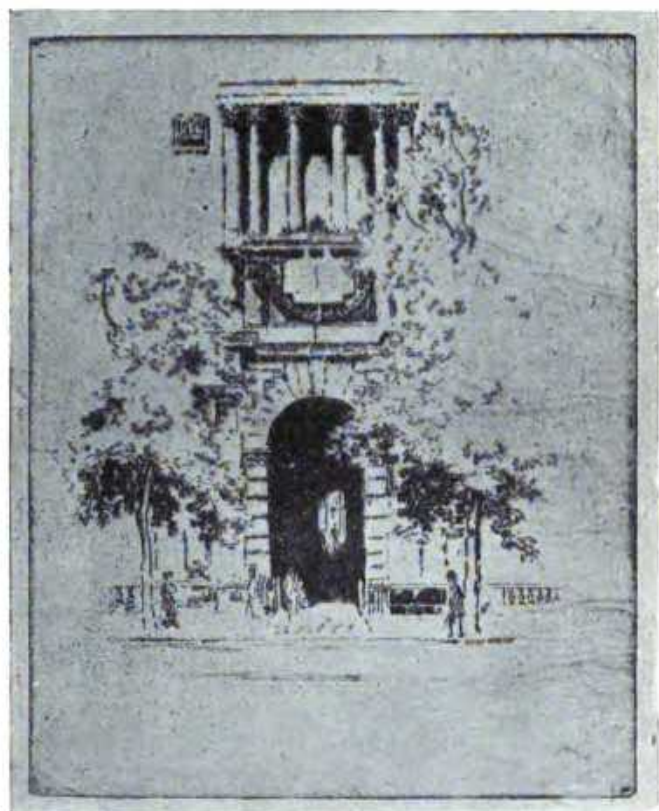

EDITOR'S NOTE

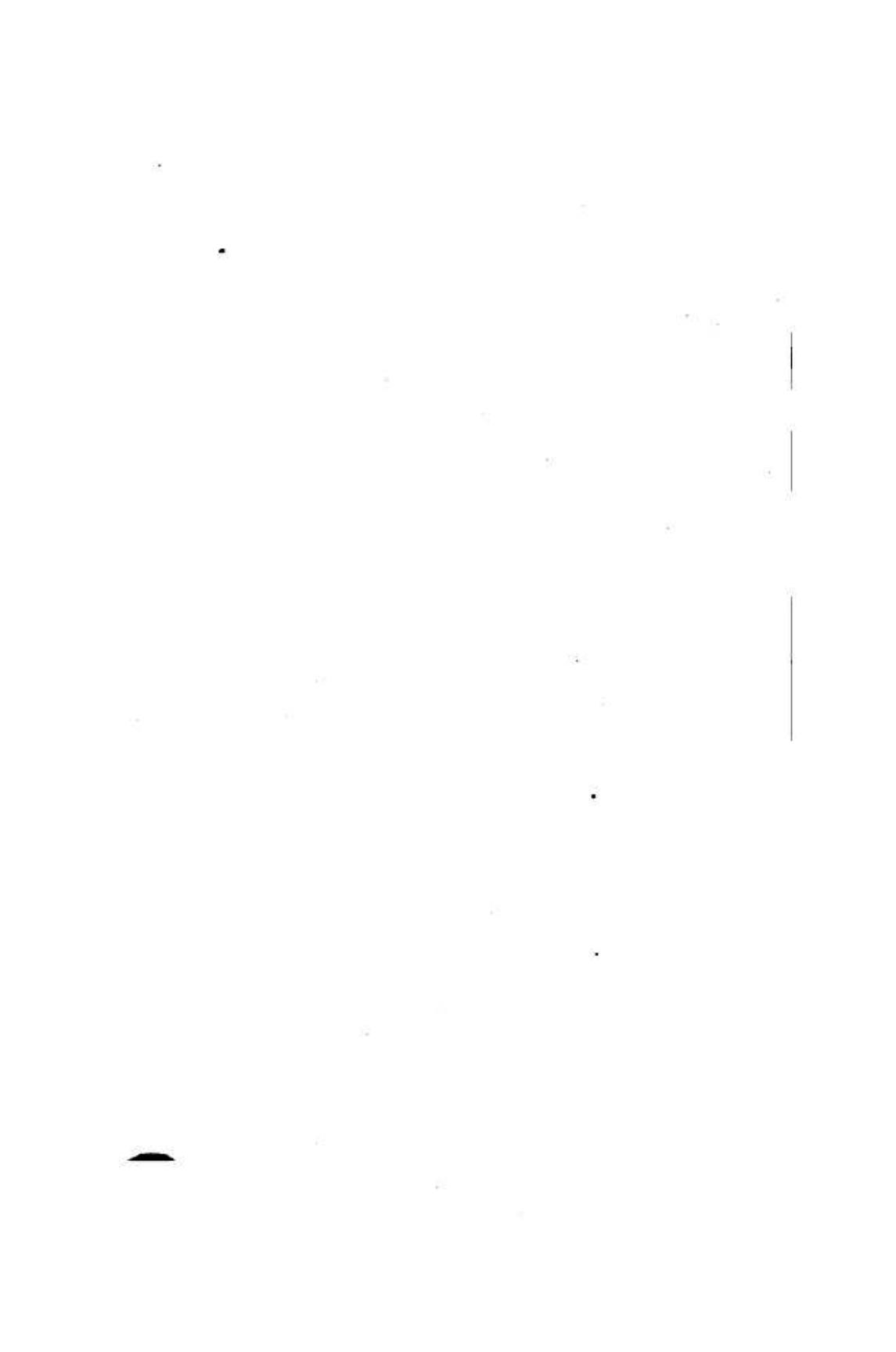
