### For-Porris.

All this early part is very uncertain, & Mr Ince sent me in 1855 a quite different account.

All on this & on the next page, except what little is enclosed in crotchets, was communicated to me by Mr T. N. Ince in 1843. He compiled it from entries in a family Bible & the communications of his grandmother. Compare p. 272, where it appears the first Stephen was the son of an earlier Stephen by Isabel Pyrrans.
