#### THE KATHAYAN SLAVE.

AT the commencement of the English and Burmese war of 1824, all the Christians (called 'hat-wearers,' in contradistinction from the turbaned heads of the Orientals) residing at Ava, were thrown unceremoniously into the Deathprison. Among them were both Protestant and Roman Catholic missionaries; some few reputable European traders; and eriminals shadowed from the laws of Christendom 'under the sole of the golden foot.'
