LETTER FROM PROFESSOR RUSKIN.

CHISLEHURST, 5th June 1885.

My DEAR FREDERICK,—

I AM delighted by the dedication of your new book to me, not only because it shows me that you have pleasure in my sympathy, but also because I want people who care about my own books to know that I can admire many things which I don't talk of. Only in thanking you for this charming compliment, you must let me guard your readers from imagining that I think exactly with you on all points. You always do me good, whether in talking or writing, by showing me the brightest side of what I may have seen mostly on the opposite one, by your memorial of the frank hearts and cheerful ways of the country people of half a century since, and your praise of frankness, cheerfulness, and simplicity in all
