This little book has been compiled to meet the wants of those who may wish to read the Bible in its chronological arrangement, rather than in the order in which it is printed in our common version.

Even the most familiar narratives of the Bible, read in this way, are clothed with a new interest, as the connection between history psalm and prophecy is seen, and we trace the course of king and prophet, or Christ and His Apostles, recorded by different writers.

While the works of many of the Bible harmonists are too large or rare to be conveniently used, this Hand-Book aims to place the results of their labors within the reach of all.

The authority used for the order of the Old Testament is that of Dr. Townsend, as his arrangement, on the basis of Lightfoot's Chronicle, is the latest which has been made in English.

The Harmony of the Gospels is that of Professor Robinson. The Acts of the Apostles, with the journeys and Epistles of St. Paul, are arranged on the authority of Dean Alford.

The notes in these works, giving reasons or citing authorities for change in the order of the sacred text, are too long to be inserted in a book of this kind; they can easily be consulted, and will often be found full of instruction and valuable suggestion.
