- 7.  $x^5 + 4x^3 2x^4 + 7x 1 (x^4 + 2x^3 2x^7 + 6x 1)$  $= x^4 + 4x^3 - 2x^2 + 7x - 1 - x^4 - 2x^3 + 2x^4 - 6x + 1 = 2x^3 + x.$
- 8.  $3a^3 2ax + x^4 (a^3 ax + x^2) = 3a^3 2ax + x^3 a^3 + ax x^4 = 2a^4 ax$
- 9. 2(a-b)-c+d-(a-b-2(c-d))=2a-2b-c+d-(a-b-2c+2d)=2a-2b-c+d-a+b+2c-2d=a-b+c-d.
