

### PREFACE TO THE THIRD EDITION.

ON presenting a Third Edition of his Poems and Songs, the Author has, in the first place, to apologise that in the previous issues there were many imperfections; and, secondly, he has with gratitude to acknowledge that, notwithstanding all their blemishes, the public favour accorded to an unknown Rhymer has been far beyond his expectations.

Many a time, in earlier years, it was his earnest desire to sing about the burns and braces, the towering hills, and leafy woods, of his native land. That he has fallen far short of singing with the pathos and power which those grand themes demand, he feels confident. He, rests, therefore, his only plea to be heard on, that he sings as well and as lovingly as he can about scenes and men endeared to him by many happy recollections.

The present Volume, it is hoped, will be found an improvement on its predecessor. Additions and corrections have been largely made, calculated to give the collection an interest not only for Ayrshire readers, but for readers everywhere. In conclusion, he confides his new venture to old friends, hopeful that neither they, nor such new patrons as he may have the good fortune to gain, will feel reason to censure him for entertaining the hope that he may, as in times past, be heard with favour.
