T is scarcely necessary to observe that the suggested "Order for a Children's Service," contained in this little book, is intended only to supplement, and in no way to be a substitute for any of the ordinary and authorized services of the Church. Where very large congregations are accustomed to attend the ordinary Sunday services of a church, the necessity of some special arrangement to meet the requirements of Children is often seriously Such, at least, has been the case at the Parish Church of Folkestone, where a distinct and separate afternoon service for the young, with suitable Prayers, metrical Litanies and Hymns, has long been the means of bringing together a large congregation of children interested in their own service, and eager for the instruction which can then be more easily imparted in the Church's way of catechising.

The Editor of the CHILDREN'S SERVICE BOOK has also had in mind the desirableness of providing a more adequate supply of Children's Hymns and Litanies, breathing the fervent but chaste spirit of the English Church, and to this end a large number of hymns have passed under review. In scarcely any instance has permission to use a copyright been refused, and the Editor desires therefore sincerely to

Then shall be sung a metrical Litany.

Then shall be said by all the Children the following prayer:—

O ever blessed JESUS: SON of GOD: and sweet Child of the Virgin Mary: Who in the days of Thy sojourn here on earth didst say : "Suffer little children to come unto Me, and forbid them not : for of such is the kingdom of heaven:" bless, we beseech Thee, us Thy children: dedicated to Thee in holy baptism: make us to be always mindful of the vow and promise: then made in our name: May we be dutiful to our parents: loving to our brothers and sisters : and obedient to our spiritual postors and teachers: As we grow in years may we grow in wisdom : and in favour with Thee: Give Thy holy angels charge over us; and let no man pluck us out of Thy hand: and grant that, being daily renewed by Thy Holy Spirit: we may continue Thy children: and attain Thy promises: Who, with the FATHER and the same Spirit : livest and reignest: GoD for ever and ever: Amen.

[COLLECT FOR THE DAY.]

The grace of our LORD JESUS CHRIST, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the HOLV GHOST, be with us all evermore. Amen.

ORDER FOR A CHILDREN'S SERVICE.

Then shall follow the Public Catechising or Address, the children first standing up and repeating together the text of Holy Scripture given out at the previous Children's Service. The text for the following Sunday shall then be given to them.

[HYMN AND BLESSING.]

Whilst the Children are leaving the Church, one by one, each Class being preceded by its tedcher, it will be found conductive to good order if one of the processional hymns be sung, the Choir retaining their places till the last verse.
